## “She Who Carries the Sun Within” The Sacred Door to the Creation,

### **Yoni Clay Ritual**

June 21<sup>st</sup> Saturday



It's time again to gather in honor of Mother Nature's great turning—the **Summer Solstice**, when **the light shines the longest and brightest** of the year.

Imagine ancient times, when our ancestors deeply understood **the Earth as a womb planet—a place of life, birth, and divine creation.**

Mother Cosmos birthed **Earth as a sacred place to bring invisible into form**—And that divine code still lives within the subconscious of the planet, visible in the **sacred cross of the equinoxes and solstices.**

That's why these turning points—like **the Summer Solstice**—have always called for ceremony, especially a ceremony to awaken **inner radiance** and embody the **feminine geometry of creation.**

#### **Molding the YONI in Clay**

In this day on **the Summer Solstice** when **the light is the most bright and longest**, we mold the **Yoni in clay** to embody the archetype of **the Sacred Gate to the Cosmic Womb**—where the light becomes form, spirit becomes matter, and the invisible becomes incarnate.

#### **Clay Making Has Its Own Medicine.**

Because **clay is earth's memory**—primal, tactile, and receptive. Its nature is feminine. This is a playful, powerful practice to honor the sacred gate and the womb space, release old stories, and embody the creative power of womanhood.

Let the clay be your prayer. Let your hands remember. Let the Sun Goddess Amaterasu come to us. By molding it into the form of our unique Yoni, we will remember our essence as a weaver and a co-creator of our lives.

- Each woman shapes her **own Yoni**, not to copy a symbol, but to remember her unique essence
- She molds not just clay—but her **authentic-self-concept**, her **womb-field**, her **receiving of light.**





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## **Honoring the Sacred Blood**

Alongside our creative Yoni molding, I will share a sacred teaching gifted to me by **Jaba Saka, the Moon Mother**, an indigenous shaman from Colombia. She is a voice of the Earth's ancient memory, and what she spoke of is not metaphor—it is ancestral truth:

**There are two kinds of blood.**

- **Sacred Blood** is the blood that brings life:

**The moon blood of our cycles** and **the birthing blood** that opens the veil between worlds. This blood is not death—it is continuity, a harmonic pulse of cosmic intelligence moving through the womb. It is conscious, offering, alive.

- **Death Blood**, by contrast, is the blood shed in violence, in war, in disconnection. It is the spilling of life without reverence, a pattern of rupture from the sacred web.

**We are now, at a tipping point in the collective field.** *The Earth has known much death blood.* The balance has tilted toward destruction. But this can change—not by “fixing”, **but by ceremony.**

**This is why our Summer Solstice gathering is so important. It is a course correction,** a turning of the wheel back to remembrance.

Jaba Saka taught us a ritual—a **way to reawaken the sacred blood**. It is a way to anchor the memory of harmony back into the Earth again.

**We will hold this ritual together.**

We will use **a red stone**—a vessel of Earth's fire, an echo of the blood within us—to honor the womb. Each woman will have the opportunity to offer her breath, her song, her silence, her intention, her memories into the stone.

This is not symbolic—it is alchemical. Through it, **we declare:**

**“My blood is sacred. My womb is wise.  
My body is the Earth remembering Herself.”**

**Let us return the memory of sacred blood to this world,  
not just for ourselves, but for the generations that follow.**



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## **Final Spiral Offering**

After the sacred blood ceremony, we go outside and sing “**Womb-Held Humming.**” Then, each woman steps forward and do the final spiral offering at the beautiful mandala space with spoken prayer.

Open the sacred door to receive the Light of the Cosmic Mother



Sculpt a sacred door—Yoni—with clay, celebrating the gateway of life



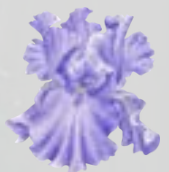
Share a beautiful teaching from Jaba Saka about the mystery of sacred blood, and conduct the sacred blood ceremony with a red stone
